

What is Title I Schoolwide

Due to the Covid19 virus, Buckeye Local did not conduct building orientations. At past orientation meetings, those in attendance would hear about Title I Schoolwide funds and how they are used to serve the students of Buckeye Local School District.

Title I, Every Student Succeeds Act (ESSA) Section 1116, is a federal program that provides financial support to schools with a large population of students that come from low-income families.

If schools have 40% or more children from low-income families, then they qualify for Schoolwide Title I, which is a program that can be used to improve the whole school and offer added services and programs to all students. All buildings in the Buckeye Local School District qualify for Schoolwide Title I services.

Some of the programs and services available in these schools are:

Teacher and principal training through Professional Development

Enhancement of education through technology

Language instruction for students with limited English proficiency (LEP)

On-going instruction for safe and drug free schools and communities

Use of new methods and technology by teachers

Early Childhood Education

Strategies that enable all students to meet their academic standards

Class reduction teachers to decrease class size

Special education - in-classroom individual instruction

Strategies to increase parental engagement

Increased instruction in reading/math

Counseling

Speech therapy
